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David Mase studied architecture and graphic design before turning to fine art. In his current works, he seeks to capture the intangible phenomena of our time—such as the flow of digital data and artificial intelligence—in visual form, translating them through the medium of painting. His works often reference everyday objects, as well as historical and pop-cultural sources. Alongside his individual practice, he collaborates with his colleague Markus Riedler on installation exhibitions and collective paintings as an artist duo. His work has been exhibited internationally, including in New York, Vienna, and Paris. He is a recipient of the Promotion Award for Fine Arts from the Federal State of Carinthia and has completed residencies at renowned international art centers.
